As one of UW Medicine's teaching hospitals, Harborview helps train tomorrow's physicians, and its faculty and staff are advancing medicine through research — attracting millions of dollars annually from federal and private sources.

Our Mission of Caring

In addition to the excellence of its care, Harborview is special because of its commitment to providing compassionate care to everyone — from a child suffering severe trauma, to a woman with an invasive brain tumor, to a homeless man with a life-threatening infection.

Many patients pay for the excellent care they receive. Harborview's Mission of Caring Fund ensures that those who can't pay — the medically underinsured, the working poor, and people with complex illnesses that have drained their family's resources — get the very same level of care. Harborview helps bridge the gap between what it costs to care for patients and what insurance and Medicaid will cover. **This is no small commitment. In fiscal year 2013, Harborview provided \$219 million in charity care, nearly one-third of all the hospital charity care in Washington state.**

Every day, and at multiple sites, Harborview's dedicated faculty and staff are saving and improving the lives of the most vulnerable citizens in King County and the state of Washington. The medical center was recognized for this work in 2007 when it received the prestigious Foster G. McCaw Prize for excellence and innovation in healthcare community service.
